


EIGHT (8) LIFE-SAVING RULES

Violation of any of the following EIGHT LIFE-SAVING RULES will result in termination of employment.

- 1. Commencing work without completing and signing the job briefing.
- 2. Climbing trees or operating an aerial device (even on the headache rack) without being 100% secured.
- 3. Breaking the Minimum Approach Distance (MAD) with any energized conductor using any body part or conductive object.
- 4. Violation of the danger zone during tree felling operations



- 1.5 times the height of the tree, for crew members
- 2 times the height for any other person
- 5. Violation of the drop zone in the work area (routine work) during tree trimming operations.



- routine work, do not enter the area delimited by cones
- 6. Utilizing company vehicle(s) without proper authorization or qualification.
- 7. Failure to fasten seat belt while operating or riding a company vehicle while in motion.
- 8. Failure to call a STOP WORK if unsure or if safety is in question.
